

**Arrowhead Architectural Committee**  
**January 17, 2006**

In attendance: Adam Kral, Bruce Wholf, Richard Cothorn, Jim Schwarzkopf, Sam Irmen, Terry Moore, William Bernard, Mark Rasmus and Holly Bristoll.

Sam Irmen reported on a trailer at the back of Applebees. Further investigation showed the trailer being used by Country Inn & Suites for refurbishing project, which will take approximately 6 more weeks.

Sam contacted Cracker Barrel regarding trailer with expired plates at the rear of their property. Adam commented he had received drawing last year for addition to building for storage, however nothing further. Mark and Adam will follow up.

Sam reported that he not only sent a letter but stopped into Outback regarding signage on windows for gift certificates. Bruce Wholf commented that exterior signage was against City code and when removed from windows Outback installed on interior of windows.

Myra Gueli of Toledo Sign submitted a request for signage for The Mutual Fund Store. Mark Rasmus moved approval of the sign as presented with the exception that there be no sign cabinet around the words "the" and "store". Bruce Wholf seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Holly Bristoll of ProMedica again submitted a request to change the existing Beaver Creek sign on the brick wall at entrance to Arrowhead Medical Center. Adam Kral stated that after reviewing files he has found no history regarding this signage. Richard Cothorn stated it is platted Beaver Creek Business Center. If changed, there would be four identification signs for this building. Bruce Wholf discussed the option of changing the street name. Bill Bernard moved to replace the sign with an embedded sign similar to Beaver Creek with concrete inlay and no ProMedica icon. The motion was tabled and will be discussed further upon Holly submitting a revised sign.

Adam Kral distributed signage for David Swesey Florist, which previously was emailed to everyone. After discussion, Richard Cothorn moved approval as presented with the exception that the logo have vacuum formed letters. Sam Irmen seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Bruce Wholf reported on the Arrowhead Park maps. Phil Enderley and Amelia of the Collaborative have not returned his calls. When returned not getting results. Collaborative owns the map. In addition, Mark has had discussions with the Collaborative about purchasing the map for the Architectural Committee.

Adam Kral inquired on how the Board felt about Arrowhead Park having a web site. He felt it could be a great resource. Adam pointed out it could be linked to the City's and Arrowhead Park Association's web sites. After discussion Mark Rasmus moved the Board go forward with getting a quote from Carl Dettmer of BGSU to set up and maintain the site. Sam Irmen seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Richard Cothorn inquired if the Board was interested in presenting retiring Board members with a plaque or some token. There was a brief discussion. The idea tabled until the next meeting.

There being nothing further, the meeting adjourned at 9:00 AM.
