

**Arrowhead Architectural Committee**  
**March 21, 2006**

In attendance: Adam Kral, Mark Rasmus, Richard Cothorn, Terry Moore, William Bernard, Bruce Wholf and Dale Fallat.

A motion by Terry Moore to approve the minutes of the previous meeting was seconded by Mark Rasmus and carried.

Ron Hornayck of Art & Sign submitted a request for signage for Playground World at 401 Tomahawk Drive. After discussion regarding the signage presented, Bruce Wholf moved to table the approval until Ron Hornayck submitted to Adam Kral a new drawing indicating all the changes requested and that drawing being approved by the Committee. William Bernard seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Lance Mushung of SSOE submitted requests for Meyer, Hill & Lynch's new building on Indian Wood Circle. After discussion, William Bernard moved approval of the first monument sign as presented noting, however, that the second name across the bottom be removed and the MHL logo be the same as the present signage. Richard Cothorn seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. The dumpster enclosure was also presented for this project. Mark Rasmus moved approval as presented with the exception that the exterior of the gate be covered in white vinyl to match the fencing. Bruce Wholf seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. The exterior lighting was presented and Bill Bernard moved to accept the lighting plan as submitted. Terry Moore seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. Finally, Lance Mushong presented the building materials for the project. They consist of the base being Adair limestone with Ariscraft Renaissance Stone, and Watsontown Fort Fetter brick. The onyx black roofing shingles are Owens Corning Oakridge Pro 40. William Bernard moved to accept the building materials as presented. Bruce Wholf seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Adam Kral presented Dale Fallat with a radio control clock as a thank you for his many years of service to the Architectural Committee and Arrowhead Park.

Adam Kral reported that the Arrowhead Park Architectural Committee's web site is up and running. The cost of \$120 per year will host two domain names on the web. Carl Dettmer inquired if the Architectural Committee would be interested in sharing the cost with Tomahawk Development. Terry Moore moved to share the web site with Tomahawk Development. Dale Fallat seconded the motion, which carried unanimously, with Mark Rasmus abstaining. .

There being nothing further, the meeting adjourned at 9:00 AM.
